

# Visiting the Travel Agents

First, a Travel Agent might ask you what kind of holiday you would like to go on.

There are lots of different types of holidays:

- City Break
- Beach
- Safari
- Cruise
- Skiing

Next, a Travel Agent might suggest some places where you would enjoy a holiday.



Once you have decided where to go, your Travel Agent will ask you where you would like to stay.

**You could stay...**

...in a villa.

...at a hotel.

...at a campsite.

...in a caravan.

- To help you to decide where you would like to stay, your Travel Agent may give you some brochures to look through.

Finally, you must decide **when** you would like to go on holiday.

You will need to have to look at your diary or calendar to see when you are free to go on holiday.

# Next:

- The Travel Agent will call where you want to stay and let them know when you will be coming to stay. This is called making a *reservation*.
- The Travel Agent will make some telephone calls to make sure that there is room for you on the coach or aeroplane on the days you would like to travel.
- Then your Travel Agent will book you some tickets to travel.
- If you are travelling abroad then your travel agent will check that you have a passport.
- Your Travel Agent will add up the cost of your holiday and tell you how much you need to pay.
- Once you have paid you will be given a receipt.
- Your travel agent will print off all of the information about your holiday and give it to you to keep.
- Your travel agent may write down their name and telephone number so that you can ring them if you have any questions.

Now that your holiday is booked you can start to think about what you need to pack!
