

## Creative Homework...

... has been designed to offer an opportunity for children to assume more responsibility in choosing, organising, presenting and taking an active role in their learning. Children must complete a minimum of 5 out of the 10 tasks by **Friday 11<sup>th</sup> December 2020.** 

The order of the tasks, choice of tasks and the frequency of completing each piece of work is up to the child, ICT can be used as and where appropriate and if desired. Homework designs are completely up to the individual. Once all 5 activities have been completed, please stick them in in the Creative Homework book and keep the book safe at home until we can ask for them to be brought back into school.

This opportunity will enhance children's learning, help prepare them for secondary school by taking responsibility for their homework and also make homework more enjoyable.

- 1. Create a **model** in a shoebox (or similar/smaller box) of a habitat.
- 2. Design the **front page of a newspaper** after an environmental disaster has occurred.
- 3. Design a word search using key environmental words.
- 4. Imagine you have £5 to spend on a healthy family meal. Create the **menu** using fair trade products and show **how** you have **spent** the money.
- 5. Create a new fair trade product and a **poster** to advertise it.
- 6. Research a part of the world affected by climate change and produce a report about it.
- Create 6 mathematical word problems and answers involving the environment.
- 8. You have survived an environmental disaster. Write a **poem** about your experience.
- Design some transport of the future to travel from Earth to a new human habitat on another planet.
- 10. Create a quiz (including answers) on an environmental topic of your choice.
