Dear Parents/Carers,

It was **absolutely wonderful** to welcome you all back to Kelvedon this morning. It was truly **joyful** to see so many smiling children, immaculate in the blue uniform, streaming into school. Thank you everyone for your support in making this happen.

Our year group meetings will take place over the next fortnight. They start at 15:30 and will be held outside under our canopy. Can I please ask that only **one** parent/carer attends with their child.

Unfortunately our 'join your child for learning' workshops will not be able to take place in their normal format. Each teacher will share with you their presentations in a format appropriate to their year group.

Our year 5 and year 6 residential visits have been cancelled or postponed due to the restrictions in place. The children will receive a letter explaining the circumstances that are relevant to their year group.

All PE kits and belongings that were left in school back in March have been passed onto your child's new class teacher and will be returned to them – I hope that items aren't too smelly!

Over the next two weeks teachers will be assessing their children to identify what gaps they have in their learning. Most of the catch up learning will take place in the class as teachers tailor their teaching to the current needs of the children. Some children, in addition to this, may receive other support funded by the government catch up scheme. Your child's class teacher will inform you if this is to happen.

The whole Kelvedon team are striving to make learning as normal and as exciting as it has always been. There will be some differences as a result of the restrictions in place, but we aim to find the best solutions to any problems. I thank you in advance for your support in our community in keeping everyone safe and in keeping our lovely school open.
