



Last Thursday we managed to trial a 'bubble' church service, which was a great success. With safe spacing the church looked full! Our year 6 readers were wonderful, as were our musicians who filled the church so beautifully with their melodies. Thanks go to Mrs Lawrence and the Y6 team for preparing the readers, Mrs Hall for supporting the musicians, Miss Hutley for planning the service and finally to Father Simon for finding a way to open up the church.

I continue to evaluate the school response to the government restrictions and the best way to reduce some of the risks.
