



Dear Parents/Carers,

I open today with exciting news! In January building work is scheduled, subject to planning permission, to start on replacement classrooms for our Nursery and the construction of a new hall.

Unfortunately the buildings have to be placed on the existing footprint of the demountable buildings in situ – this means that I need to temporarily relocate the Nursery children and the ABC club.

To prepare for this building work I have had to make a range of preparations so that it can take place smoothly. A letter has been sent to those directly affected by these preparations giving more details. For everyone else it will be business as usual. It will be great to finally remove all of the old demountable structures.
