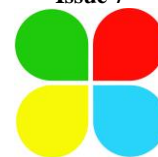

Dear Parents/Carers,

Great news from the government that we will be FULLY re-opening school to ALL children on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. We are all very excited and very relieved to be getting the children back into school.

Thank you everyone for all of your incredible work coping with learning at home – you have all been magnificent.

Obviously the National Lockdown IS NOT over and we still have to remember to maintain all of our Covid safety measures. Tomorrow, Friday, you will be sent a whole school letter explaining the measures and a year group specific letter with information about arrival and collection. Please make sure that you read them so that we can do everything we can to stay open and avoid any further lockdowns.

Our main areas of difficulty are drop off and collection. Drop off worked better in the autumn with our trickle flow and with Y3, 4, 5 and 6 parents/carers NOT entering the site. Children got into class quickly and adults, limited to ONE for YN, R, 1 and 2, cleared the site quickly.

Because we have 3 gates, and families come from all directions, keeping them as in/out rather than one way gates reduced the time adults were on site and any congestion.

At pick up, it is helpful if older children can safely walk home on their own. I am asking you, this time, to form socially distanced lines in designated areas at pick up to help the swift transfer of children to you and then immediate exiting of the site – please make sure that you are supervising your children if you have to join other lines for later pickups.

I have kept all of the information I am sending you as brief and to the point as I can – I hope this is helpful.

Our focus over the 18 days in school before the Easter break will be to support children's well-being, socialization and rebooting their love for learning. This will be done through exciting practical learning projects and topics designed to build back the confidence and esteem of every pupil.

School will be closed on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March for Vulnerable children and those of Critical Key Workers and live lessons will not take place in order that staff can come into school and make preparations for opening on Monday 8<sup>th</sup>.
