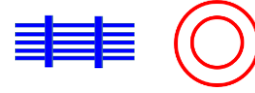

Welcome back everyone to our exciting summer term of learning. I hope that as the warmer weather returns our unique way of learning at Kelvedon will once more take off. I love to see the children exploring their learning practically, taking responsibility, risks and being independent. The last two years have been restrictive in these terms, but hopefully that is now all behind us.

This half term will end with our Platinum Jubilee celebrations. Below is some more detailed information about what will be happening.

Monday 23rd May – Red, White and Blue Day:

- Everyone comes to school dressed in red, white and blue.
- Each class learns about a commonwealth country throughout the week.
- 10.00am Church Service for children and staff (sorry no parents) honouring and celebrating the Queen.

Tuesday 24th May - Art Day:

- All children contribute to an outside mural commemorating the Platinum Jubilee.

Wednesday 25th May - Commonwealth Games:

- Each class will learn a game, typical of their commonwealth country, and on a round robin it is taught to, and played by, each class. AM Key stage 2, PM Key stage 1.

Thursday 26th May - AM Commonwealth Day:

- Each class can come dressed in their commonwealth country's colours or national dress. A parade will take place around the school field followed by classes pairing up and sharing with each other what they have learnt.

- Children bring in their best clothes and dress for the occasion. Each class provide their own 'bring and share' picnic. A mass school dance will take place in honour of the Queen.
- There will be an open air disco and the presentation of Jubilee mugs.

Next Wednesday to Friday Year 5 embark on their residential visit to Danbury Outdoor Centre. I will be attending the adventure with them and am looking forward to spending some quality time with the children.

On the afternoon of Wednesday 4th May our Key stage 2 Athletics Finals Day returns. All children have been competing in heats within their class PE lessons and those that have qualified as the fastest competitors will be representing their class during the event. The front ramp gate will be open at 1.20pm and the first race will start at 1.40pm – parents/carers are welcome to join us at this event should you wish to, please bring your own camp chair to sit on.

Please can parents/carers avoid 'catching' teachers first thing in the morning, unless it is extremely urgent, as this is an important time when they greet and welcome the children. Teachers are happy to meet with you after school to discuss your concerns – please contact the office to make an appointment.
