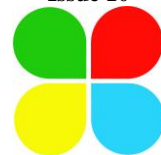

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Monday Mrs Bull took our athletics team to the district event at the Garrison taking 3rd place overall in years 3 and 4. Years 5 and 6's effort was commendable and they reached the finals in many of their races. The team won an array of glittering medals and were again terrific ambassadors for our school. Congratulations to everyone who took part and particularly to Mrs Bull who trained the children every Friday morning before school.

Next Tuesday, Mrs Bull is in action again as she coordinates our Sports Day and Family Picnic. Here are the details for the event. I do hope you will be able to join us and cheer your children on:

- Key Stage 1 (years R, 1 and 2) start their sports at 11.15am on the main field and gates will open at 11am for parents/carers to join us.
- The picnic begins for everyone at 12.30pm on the back field and ends at 1pm with children needing to be back in class by 1.15pm. The gate will be open for Key Stage 1 parents/carers to fetch their picnics from cars and for the arrival of Key Stage 2 parents/carers. Teachers bring classes out to the field and children join you for their picnic. If you can't make it, your child's class teacher will hold a picnic with them.

*If your child requires a school picnic meal it can be booked as usual on ParentPay.

At 1pm the gates are opened for parents/carers of KS1 to leave and for further arrivals of KS2 parents/carers.

- Key Stage 2 (years 3, 4, 5 and 6) start their sports events on the main and back field at 1.30pm and it should all be over by 3pm.
- It WILL be warm and sunny! – Bring a hat and sun cream!

I look forward to welcoming you this evening between 5pm and 7pm at our Open Evening of Learning. You and your family are welcome to come along, visit all of the classrooms, join in the learning opportunities in each room and watch some of the special demonstrations. This is just one event in which you get to see first-hand some of the ways in which we learn here at Kelvedon. Mrs Osborne, my replacement, will be at the event and would be delighted to meet with you so please say hello if you see her around.

Don't forget that school is closed to pupils tomorrow as the teaching teams all prepare for the learning in the new academic year.
