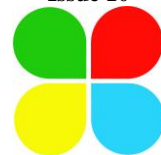

Dear Parents/Carers,

Last Friday Mr Collingwood organised yoga sessions for a number of classes in the school. The children thoroughly enjoyed learning how to relax their bodies and minds and develop their well-being. Last Friday Year 6 held their annual Enterprise Event. With Covid restrictions they had to rethink their format and be resourceful to make it safe for everyone. The funds they raise go towards replenishing and enhancing the shared play equipment as their legacy. This year they raised a staggering £665.85! Congratulations to all of the Year 6 team on this tremendous achievement.

The Year 2 and 3 teams have worked incredibly hard to make sure that the children have had an opportunity to take part in a production this year. Parish Council members had to have a quiet word with a couple of the younger children who were jumping up and down on the flowers – I am sad to say they were from our school! On another issue, local residents have once again complained about irresponsible and selfish parking in Kingfisher Way of some parents/carers.
