

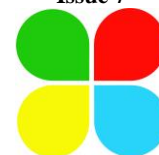

Mrs Osborne, the new headteacher from September, has joined the school for the summer term for a period of handover. She will be attending our events and I will introduce you to her at each one. I am sure you will make her very welcome.

Our Open Evening of Learning will be taking place on Thursday 30<sup>th</sup> June – it's been a long time since we have been able to hold this event! This event is an opportunity for you and your family to come into school and to see how we learn in the different year groups at Kelvedon. It runs between 5pm and 7pm and we have some wonderful activities for you to try your hand at in each classroom. There are lots of special events and showcases taking place around the whole school. Please keep the date in your diary and bring the whole family and experience the fantastic learning at Kelvedon.

Another event that will make a full come back, that many of you are yet to experience, is our Sports Day and Family Picnic on Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> July. This is how the day unfolds:

- Key Stage 1 (years R, 1 and 2) start their sports at 11.15am on the main field and gates will open at 11.00am for parents/carers to join us.
- The picnic begins for everyone at 12.30pm on the back field. The gate will be open for Key Stage 1 parents/carers to fetch their picnics from cars and for the arrival of Key Stage 2 parents/carers. Teachers bring classes out to the field and children join you for their picnic. If you can't make it, your child's class teacher will hold a picnic with them.

\*If your child requires a school picnic meal it can be booked as usual on ParentPay.

At 1pm the gates are opened for parents/carers of KS1 to leave and for further arrivals of KS2 parents/carers.

- Key Stage 2 (years 3, 4, 5 and 6) start their sports events on the main field at 1.30pm and it should all be over by 3pm.
- It WILL be warm and sunny! – Bring a hat and sun cream!

The Kelvedon World Cup for boys and girls in years 4, 5 and 6 starts on Monday. It's just a bit of fun and is something that I first did with my school 35 years ago and I seem to still be running it! Lots of the staff join in and help with the event.

Finally, may I remind you that tomorrow's sharing assembly will be 2C, Miss Crace's class. It starts at 9.10am and parents/carers of class 2C are welcome to join us.
