Xmas Infant Disco

The Infant Disco (Reception, Years 1 and 2) will start at 3.30pm and finish at **4.30pm** (please note time). Please ensure that your child brings their disco clothes with them into school in a **clearly named bag** in the morning. They will get changed at school and will be taken into the disco by their class teacher. Children may want to dress in Party clothes or fancy dress costumes or come as they are.

The cost of the disco is £2.50. We will be using **Parent Pay** again to take payments. Please go to the Parent Pay website to pay and tick the consent box online (to confirm that you consent to your child attending the disco) **by the end of the day on Wednesday 12th December** at the latest (after this the option to pay online will be removed). If we do not receive payment and consent your child will need to be collected from school at 3.20pm as usual.

Please collect your child at **4.30pm**. We kindly request that parents do not enter the school building, but wait for their children in the normal pick area.

- **If SOMEONE ELSE IS COLLECTING YOUR CHILD:** please provide the **Name of the child, Class** and details of named person collecting your child.
- **CHILDREN WITH ALLERGIES AND INHALERS:** if your child has any allergies to any of the food products (packet sweets such as Haribos, laces, chew bars and potato crisps) that will be available at the disco, with your **child's name, class and allergen.** We will not have access to school inhalers and so if your child requires one please ensure they have it with them and they know how to use it. A School First Aider will be available.

SWEETS

- **We are introducing a new system for purchasing sweets/crisps in order to stop children buying too many sweets. They will only be able to queue up once and be given a stamp on their hand when they have purchased their sweets. £1.50 will be sufficient for your child to buy sweets and crisps, please bring in a named purse or envelope. Soft drinks will be supplied free of charge**
- **In addition, we will be selling tattoos at a cost of 20p per tattoo**
- **May we also ask that no mobile phones/Electronic Games/'Heelies' or similar roller shoes be brought to the disco**
- **We have decided to try something new and have a Children Party Entertainer to keep the children engaged and have a great time, this will include, a magic show, balloons, puppets and a mini disco.**

We are looking for helpers and are often very short of volunteers at the Infant Discos.
