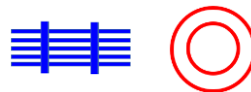

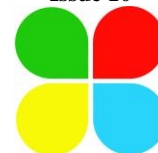

The hard work of gardener George Bell, ably supported by the voluntary help of Mr Hall, has made the children's designs come to life. As the plants establish they will form a sensory border – thank you for respecting the garden and the hard work that has gone into making it.

The work on our covered playground will finally begin on Monday 26th November. This project has been funded over two years by your fabulous PTFA. It was due to be started last Easter but was held up by the planning process. A special thank you to Mrs Smale for her hard work project managing this great new addition to the school. Safety fencing will be onsite for about 8 days, but your access should not be interrupted.

The session is free and I hope you will take advantage of this superb opportunity.
