#### Departure

The children will be leaving during school time and returning before the end of the school day. Children should dress in non-uniform on the day of departure. A packed lunch on departure day is not required as lunch will be served at Bradwell.

#### Activities

The children will be taking part in a range of adventurous and water based activities.

#### Packing

Please encourage your child to pack their own bag using the kit list that can be found on the reverse of this letter. Please ensure they pack suitable clothing for the time of year. However, please note that Bradwell activity centre will provide all waterproof clothing appropriate for sailing and other water-based activities, including trousers. It is important the children have sun cream as it can be easy to become burnt when sailing. All bedding is provided by the centre.

#### Mobile phones, electronic games and sweets

Please ensure that your child **does not** bring a mobile phone with them on the school journey. No electronic equipment is to be brought on the school trip either. Please support the class teachers by ensuring your child does not bring chocolate or sweets with them.

#### Spending Money

Spending money is not required.

#### Medication

If your child requires any medication, please ensure it is named and full details of how and when it should be administered are provided. Medicine should be handed in to Miss Burton in the school office just before or on the day of departure. If your child requires motion sickness tablets for the coach or boat, these should also be handed in to the office.

#### Notification of safe arrival

Notification of a safe arrival will be posted on the year five blog. If there is a substantial change in the return time, you will be notified via the school text service.
