I have managed to keep school meal prices well below that of other schools to support you all during the difficult financial time. From September daily meal prices will be rising to £2.30, which is still far less than other schools are charging.

Information for Parents of Children in Year 3 from September 2019 Re: Free School Meals. Automatic entitlement to a free school meal finishes at the end of Year 2 and only children from low income families are eligible from Year 3 onwards. Children may be eligible for free school meals if their parents receive the following benefits: Universal Credit, provided the annual net earned income does not exceed £7,400 (£616.37 per month) Income Support, Income Based Employment and Support Allowance. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-free-school-meals.

Please see the school's website for information on how to order and pay for school meals on ParentPay. Please note that if a meal is not ordered by the weekly cut off, parents/carers will need to provide a packed lunch for their child.

Unusually, tomorrow, we have a sharing assembly on the last day of term! This will be year 3, Mrs Colgrave's and Miss Taylor's classes. It starts at 09:10am and Parents/Carers of classes 3C and 3T are welcome to join us.
